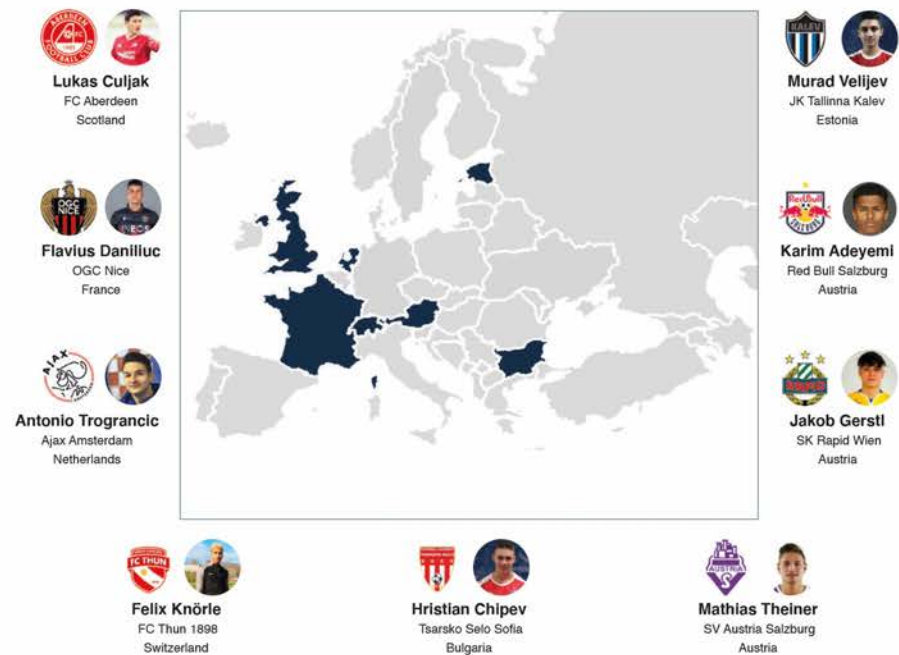

- 5 pitches (indoor and outdoor), gym, fitness center and sand area

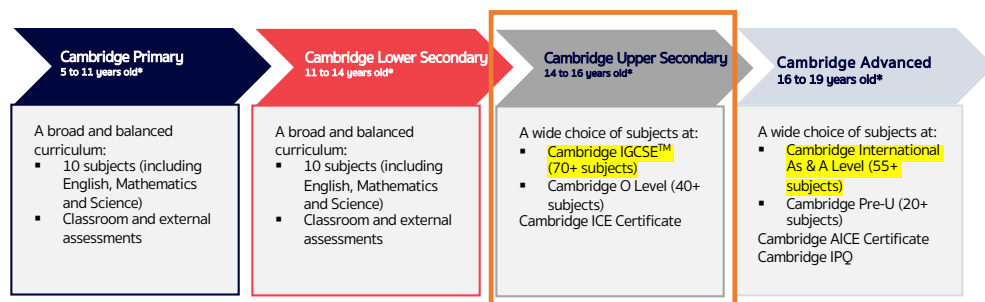
